# AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 1, GENERAL PROVISIONS AND CHAPTER 5, ANIMALS AND FOWL OF THE CHANHASSEN CITY CODE 

## THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHANHASSEN, MINNESOTA ORDAINS:

Section 1. The Chanhassen City Code is amended by adding the following definitions to Section 1-2 Rules of construction:
"Chicken or domesticated chicken" means a subspecies of the species Gallus domesticus.
"Coop" means the structure for the keeping or housing of chickens.
"Hen" means a female chicken.
"Rooster" means a male chicken.
"Run" means an enclosed and covered area attached to the coop where the chickens can roam unsupervised.

Section 2. The Chanhassen City Code is amended by amending Sec. 5-133. Density and setbacks (a) (1) to read "Lots ene acre or larger but smaller than $21 / 2$ acres: Eight chickens."
a. Have a lot one acre or larger.

Section 3. The Chanhassen City Code is amended by amending Sect Sec. 5-32. Permit required. to read as follows:

## Sec. 5-132. Permit required.

(c) In order to be issued a permit the applicant must:
(1) Have a lot one acre or larger.
(1 2$)$ Have as the principal use of the property a single-family residential structure.
(2 3)Submit a notarized statement to the city stating that they have informed all adjoining neighbors that they intend to keep chickens.
(3 4)Not have had a prior chicken permit revoked by the City of Chanhassen.
(4 5)Meet the density and setback requirements listed in section 5-133.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage and publication.
